Key financial year dates for businesses



From 1 Julu to 31 October. Use the interactive check box to record your progress.

- Individual income tax returns can be completed from now until 31 October if preparing and lodging yourself.

14 JULY

- Employers must issue PAYG withholding payment summaries to employees by this date. Note: This can be done via your STP lodgment.



28 JULY

- Lodge and pau Q4 (APR - JUN) BAS if you lodge quarterly.

- Super guarantee contributions for Q4 (APR - JUN) are due.



14 AUGUST

- PAYG withholding payment summary annual report is due.



28 OCTOBER

- Lodge and pay your Q1 (JUL -SEP) BAS - if you lodge quarterly.

- Super guarantee contributions for Q1 (JUL - SEP) are due.



31 OCTOBER

- Last day to submit individual income tax returns.



From 28 January to 30 June.



28 JANUARY

- Super guarantee contributions for Q2 (OCT - DEC) are due.



28 FEBRUARY

- Lodge and pay Q2 (OCT - DEC) BAS - if you lodge quarterly.



28 APR

- Lodge and pay Q3 (JAN - MAR) BAS - if you lodge quarterly.

- Super guarantee contributions for Q3 (JAN - MAR) are due.



15 MAY

- Company income tax returns are due for lodgement and payment.
- Partnership & Trust Income tax returns are due for lodgement.
 - Individual income tax returns due for lodgement if you're using a tax agent.



21 MAY

- The Fringe Benefit Tax return is due by today if you lodge by paper. Note: The FBT tax year runs from April 1 to March 31.



28 MAY

- The Fringe Benefit Tax return is due by today if you lodge electronically. Note: The FBT tax year runs from April 1 to March 31.



30 JUNE

- Prepare for end of financial year and wrap up your books for the 2025/26 year.
